## **S**tudent **M**obile **A**cademic **R**esponse **T**eam

The STUDY SQUAD program through Minds on Learning offers elementary, middle and high school students ONLINE after school tutoring in all four U.S. time zones. Students who are members of the Study Squad and their parents have the option to text our dispatch center and request an “immediate same-day” tutoring block or schedule an instructional session days in advance.

Our academic “coaches” are part of a nationwide network of SMART TEAM members who log in to tutor students in specific content areas while also providing kids the confidence and study skills that enhance success. SMART TEAM members are university students, outstanding students in high school, and other educators from throughout the country who have specific knowledge and abilities in one or more of the secondary school academic content areas (mathematics, science, English, history, etc.) or specific skills in responding to the needs of one or more instructional age groups.

Those who participate as tutors have agreed to be part of a SMART TEAM group text thread. When a Study Squad student or parent makes a “same-day” or “by appointment” text request to our dispatch center, a message is immediately sent to the text thread. Available SMART TEAM members have three options. They may text back that they are available to provide assistance, indicate they are not available, or simply not respond if busy (away from phone, in class themselves, or involved with other commitments).

This type of “Uber-real-time” response allows SMART TEAM members to go about their daily business without directly having to commit availability on a particular day or be on-call at a specific time. SMART TEAM members, many being students themselves with busy schedules, often carry their computers in a backpack and have them readily available to log in from nearly anywhere.

## ***JOIN the SMART TEAM***

Typically, the first SMART TEAM member available with the requisite skills will be assigned by the dispatch center. Once attached to a dispatch, the SMART TEAM member will log in to meet the student in a designated online room to begin a tutoring session that lasts between 40 and 60 minutes.

Since the STUDY SQUAD operates online in four U.S. time zones, SMART TEAM members may live and/or go to school in any part of the country. Although there are no expectations that TEAM members are just waiting to be called, the goal of course is to have enough members in the program so that at least one is available for each dispatch. Before making application to the SMART TEAM program, individuals should assess their own personal schedules. In order to make participation worthwhile, tutors will need to have some availability each week within the hours Study Squad is offered — 3pm to 7pm, Monday through Friday.

SMART TEAM members will be compensated at a rate aligned with their years in school and their experience within our program. Similar to the teachers who work with children in classrooms, individuals wishing to be tutors in this program must interview (in person and/or online) with a member of our admin team, supply credible references, and clear a criminal background check.

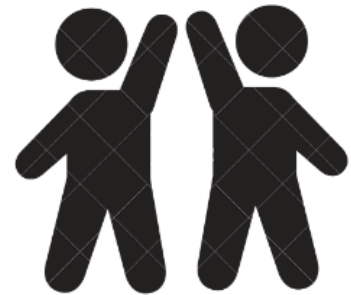
